General Responsibilities

- 1. Maintain effective communication with the Site Director/Coordinator and/or school personnel at assigned site.
- 2. Follow direction of Site Director/ Coordinator or other manager(s) with respect to policies and procedures and adhere to program requirements.
- 3. Lead, participate in and take responsibility for afterschool program activities at assigned site.
- 4. Participate in out-of-school time program planning and design.
- 5. Meet with parents, students and community members; communicate in a respectful and confidential manner.
- 6. Identify needed supplies and resources and inform Site Director/ Coordinator.
- 7. Participate in professional development and program-related training activities.
- 8. Perform all other duties as assigned by supervisor.

Preferred Competences

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
- Experience working in a school- or community-based out-of-school time organization
- Knowledge of afterschool programs, communities and/or positive youth development
- Bilingual (English and Spanish/Haitian Creole)

Requirements: Must have or complete a cleaned DCF background check and fingerprinting prior to employment. She/he agrees to complete 5 hours' emergent literacy within 10 business days from the date of hire, 40 hours DCF Child Care Certification Course within 90 days from the date of hire, 10 Hours yearly in-service, CPR and First Aid on or before the first year of employment, possesses a Florida Driver License and CDL preferred. Be willing to enroll and pursue certificate of degree in School-Age Child Care Youth Development within two years from the date of hire.
